An Inspiring Venue

Kelham Island Museum can be hired for evening receptions and dining, social occasions, conferences and meetings.

Located in one of the city's oldest industrial districts, the Museum stands on a man-made island which is over 900 years old. The Museum building was originally the Kelham Iron Works in the 1800s before being bought by the city in 1890 to become an electricity generating station for the original tram system.

With the River Don running down one side and the man made goit

(mill stream) on the other, there is no comparable location.



The galleries and exhibitions explore life and work in Sheffield during the Industrial Revolution, through the Victorian Era and two world wars and show how steelmaking forged both the City and the world!

Dining and Receptions

The Museum exhibition areas can be used for mid - sized occasions.

The reception area (map - Why Sheffield?) with the magnificent Town Guns is an ideal dining location for up to 100 guests.



Alternatively this area is perfect for welcoming delegates for canapé or buffet evenings. With canapés and buffets capable of being served from several locations around the galleries, a less formal occasion and atmosphere can be created.



With an area ideal for music and dancing which will not dominate the dining area and Museum galleries.

The Upper Gallery can be used for exhibitions and product launches as well as dining and corporate events.

Seating up to 250 for dining, the room can be dressed to suit any theme and is large enough to accommodate a stage, bar and dance floor.



There are two areas perfect for fine dining for smaller occasions, up to 30 guests. Dine alongside the awesome River Don Engine or in the Crucible Shop.



Summer Bar Be Que

For picturesque and informal events, the end of the island or the Stone Garden are perfect for a Bar Be Que.



Conferences and Meetings

The meeting rooms have a range of capacities up to 75 theatre style. Each room has its own style and strengths.

For larger conferences, the Upper Gallery provides room for main sessions and break out groups.



The other rooms are ideal for team away days and training sessions.

There are also rooms available at Abbeydale Industrial Hamlet.



These have a more intimate and atmospheric feel, as they are in the original Hamlet buildings and will provide a truly memorable venue for any meeting. While there you can find the origins of the expression: *“back to the grindstone”*
